You can reduce utilities costs by using simple energy and water saving techniques.

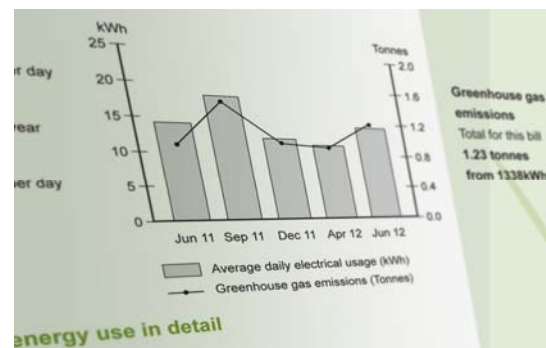
Find out how by participating in a free Environment and Sustainability Champions Training Workshop.
